Certified Lead Training is Required by 4/22/2010 EPA's New Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule Affects You!

The Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Rule affects contractors, remediators, property managers, and others who disturb more than 6 square feet of interior or 20 square feet of exterior known or presumed lead-based paint.

This new rule covers any work performed including painting and remodeling, that results in the disturbance of painted surfaces in pre-1978 homes and child-occupied facilities. Examples include removal or modification of painted components such as doors; repairing a painted surface or preparing it for repainting by sanding, scraping, or by performing any action that may generate paint dust; removal of walls, ceilings, and other structures, re-plastering, re-plumbing, weatherization work that disturbs painted surfaces, and all window replacement.

By April 22, 2010, firms must have one or more "Certified Renovators" assigned to jobs where lead-based paint is disturbed. To become certified, a renovator must successfully complete an 8-hour training course conducted by an EPA-accredited training provider.

Occupational and Environmental Health Consulting Services, Inc. has partnered with the IAQA Chicago Chapter and the National Center for Healthy Housing, an EPA-accredited training provider, to provide Certified Renovator training. Classes will include both lecture and hands-on activities as well as a certification exam.

Classes are limited to 36 students.
