Incidents and awareness of mold and mildew growth on building materials has been rapidly increasing over the past several years. As a result, specialized mold resistant coatings have been designed for use in areas prone to mold growth. This course will cover current uses and applications of mold resistant coatings for mold remediation, HVAC systems, commercial applications, and pro-active use in new construction.
